

Lexington Parks and Recreation may photograph or video participants enrolled in activities, classes, or programs, or in City of Lexington parks. These are used in program guides, brochures, website, social media, and other media publications.

CHANGES AND REFUNDS

Programs have a minimum number of participants needed, and participants must register by the deadline. You are entitled to a full refund for a cancelled program. Payments made in cash or by check are processed in accordance with our accounts payable schedule, and typically issued within 7-14 business days. We do not give refunds for programs after they begin.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The full registration fee for a program is due at the time of registration. No spots will be held without full payment. We will take waiting lists for programs that are filled and expand a class if possible. Residents are those that live within city limits and support Lexington Parks and Recreation through property taxes. The best way to determine residency is to check your property tax bill, or contact us.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If it becomes unsafe to run or continue a program due to inclement weather, we will postpone or cancel the event. For cancelled shelter reservations, users have three (3) business days to reschedule. There will be no refunds given for shelter reservations. For closures and cancellations, call our weather hotline 336-248-3969, or check our Facebook page: @lexparksandrec.

The cost is \$25 for city residents and for non-residents it is \$50. Reservation fees are non-refundable. If a cancellation due to inclement weather is necessary, an alternate date can be scheduled, but must be done within three (3) business days, and must be within the current calendar year.
